## Family Prayer Activity Pilgrim Footprints and Family Jubilee Prayer


### **Cut Out Footprints**

#### YOU WILL NEED:

Paper, pencils, scissors, stapler

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

- Have everyone take their shoes off.
- Take turns to trace each others feet on some paper and cut them out.
- Write your Jubilee hopes on your feet.
- As you trace and cut, think about the pilgrim saints who have gone before us.



- To display them, collect them all together like a bouquet and place somewhere in the home, like on the fridge, table or blue tac to the wall near your Family Jubilee Prayer.
- Alternatively, you could print out and stick the Jubilee Prayer in the center of a large poster. Then stick your footprints around the prayer to create a border.
- · Say the Family Jubilee prayer together

If you're feeling adventurous, you could create your footprints using paint, then take turns to help wash each others feet!
