## Jubilee Poster

### Pilgrims of Hope footprints

The theme of this years' Jubilee is 'Pilgrims of Hope'.

The closer we are to Jesus, the more we know how much he loves us, the more we can share God's love with others. That is what makes us people who are filled with hope!

Sometimes we need reminding though!

Make this poster and put it somewhere for everyone in your home, church or classroom to see as a reminder to stay close to Jesus and share his love with everyone so that they can have hope too!

#### PILGRIMS OF HOPE POSTER

##### YOU WILL NEED:

- large table cloth or piece of calico
- poster paint
- trays and sponges
- buckets, wash cloths and towels
- large black marker or black paint and a brush

##### BEFORE YOU START:

- Talk to the children about the theme of the year of Jubilee.
- What does 'hope' mean? Who helps us be hope-filled? How can we give others 'hope'.

##### INSTRUCTIONS

- Have everyone take their shoes off
- One at a time, step into the paint tray and then walk across the table cloth, leaving your prints as you go.
- At the other end, wash you feet in the bucket and put your shoes back on.
- As you walk, think about the people who have gone before us. Think about how you are joining them in walking with Jesus! Together we are 'Pilgrims of Hope'!
- When the footprints are dry, write or paint 'Pilgrims of Hope' in large letters through the centre of the table cloth. The display!
