## Proclamation of faith - The Apostles Creed

As baptised Catholics, we share in a beautiful faith that comes from an encounter with the risen Jesus. The profession of faith captures the main truths or beliefs that Catholics hold on to in their walk with Jesus, and witness to throughout their lives. The two of the most well known creeds are the Nicene Creed and the Apostles Creed.

The Apostles Creed is particularly helpful for children because it is the shortest. This activity not only helps kids become familiar with the words of this creed but also could be used to pray this beautiful profession during Children's Liturgy of the Word or classroom prayer.

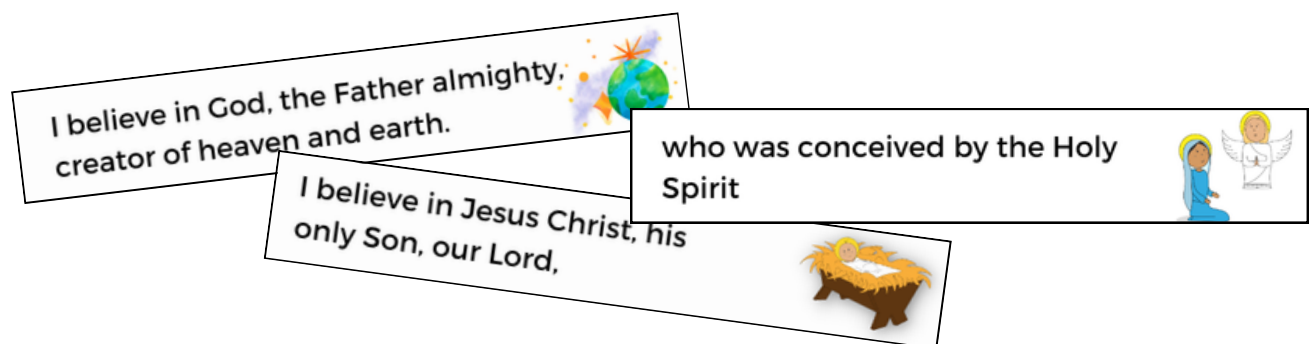
### APOSTLES CREED STRIPS

#### YOU WILL NEED:

- print out of the Apostles Creed strips (suggest A3)
- Note - these are in an accompanying document
- optional: laminate if you wish to use these multiple times

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

- Talk to the children about the Apostles Creed so they have context for this activity.
- Place the strips in order so that the children can see the words and images.
- Read it through once or twice.
- Gather up the strips and share them among the children. Then work together to put the strips back in the correct order (there is a card with the strips in order on the next page to help!)
