Forgiveness Write your own Act of Contrition



This is one of the prayers we can use when we make an act of contrition during the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation, also called Confession or Penance, is where you can tell a priest about the things you've done wrong, and ask God for forgiveness. This is just like when you apologize to a friend and they forgive you. The priest says the words that Jesus says to us, and Jesus, through the priest forgives us of our sins and gives us fulness of life again! In this year of Jubilee we're reminded to think about the things we might need to say sorry for so we can recieve God's mercy and grace to start again.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Talk to the children about the importance of seeking forgiveness from God when we've done something hurtful to ourselves or others.
 Encourage them to think about times when they've experienced having to seek forgiveness from family or friends.
- Tell the children that this is a reflective activity where they'll have some time between themselves and God.
- Tell them they can take the "sorry prayer" and write it again in their own words in the space provided.
- Have the children begin by making the Sign of the Cross and invite
 Jesus to help as they write their prayer.
- During the prayer time, play the song with the YouTube link provided or any reflective song about God's mercy that you think is appropriate.
