Luke 10:1-9


What would Jesus do?



This activity is designed to help the children think about how they would share the love and Good News of Jesus with others in a variety of situations.

Set up:

- Come up with a number of different scenarios or use some from the list below and add them to a whiteboard/butchers paper.
- Ask the children what they think Jesus would do in that situation and get them to write their responses next to it.
- Then ask what they can do in this situation.



Scenario's

- At school, your friends start talking badly about another friend who isn't there.
 - Someone is not being included in games and play at break time.
 - You see a homeless person on the street who is hungry.
 - Your big brother or sister has lots of homework to do but also has a lot of chores to do at home.
 - Mum and Dad have had very busy days, and still have lots to do like cook dinner, get packed lunches ready, tidy the house.
 - Someone is bullying another person and getting people to laugh at them.
 - Someone in your class is really struggling to understand their work and feels bad about themselves.
- Make up some of your own based on your knowledge of the children.
