Overview

Set up a prayer space at the front or in the middle of the room and get the children to sit around it. The idea is to help the children understand that their relationship with Jesus is important

What Jesus was telling Martha in todays gospel is to put first things first. Jesus wants our relationship with him to be one of these important things that we prioritise in life, we make it important.

Decorate stones with an image of Jesus that is important to you, it can be a cross, his face or it could be a scripture from the bible. Put thse stones somewhere that you will see them every morning. It might be on your bedside table, next to your toothbrush, with the breakfast cereal.

Then when you see it you will be reminded to think about Jesus and say a simple prayer to him. Ask him to help you remember to put first things first and to help make your relationship stronger and stronger.
