Prepare for this prayer by printing a copy of the Our Father for each child. You could use the one on the following page or another of your choice.

If possible, arrange the children in a circle and invite them to to close their eyes and think about a place in the world or somebody they know who needs prayers. Pass a small object from the sacred space e.g. a pebble, a small cross, battery operated tea light, around the circle. When a person has the object, they say their prayer out loud if they wish, or to themselves. Then, finish by praying the Our Father together.
