

Year C - 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 12:16-21

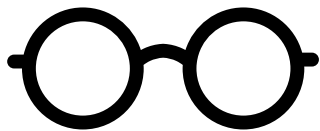
Being thankful and generous - being mindful of the needs of others



This activity encourages children to look for and notice the needs of others. There are two options”

- Make some craft glasses to help us remember to see others as God sees them (you can also buy these from party shops to avoid the cutting)
- Make a magnifying glass

You will need:



- printed template printed on card for each child (see next page)
- Cellophane paper (clear or coloured (cut them to size ahead of time).
- Scissors
- Glue/tape (in case of breaks)
- Materials to decorate: coloured pencils/pens, washi tape, stickers, sequins, glitter glue etc

Instructions:

1. Hand out the template and get the children to decorate their glasses, then carefully cut them out. They may need help cutting out the eye holes.
2. Make the lenses out of cellophane paper or transparency film. Cut a pair to a size and shape that covers each eye hole. Glue the lenses at the back of the frame.

You will need:



- printed template printed on card for each child (see next page)
- Cellophane paper (clear or coloured (cut them to size ahead of time).
- Scissors
- Glue/tape
- Craft sticks (optional)
- Materials to decorate: coloured pencils/pens, washi tape, stickers, sequins, glitter glue etc

Instructions:

1. Hand out the template and get the children to decorate their magnifying glass, then carefully cut them out. They may need help cutting out the hole.
2. Make the lens out of cellophane paper or transparency film. Cut a circle to the size and shape that covers the hole. Glue the lens at the back of the magnifying glass frame.
3. Optional: If needed, secure a craft stick to one side of the magnifying glass handle to strengthen.
