Here are a selection of sheep crafts for the children to make to explore today's gospel further.

Pom Poms

You will need:

wool, scissors and two small cardboard tubes and printouts of sheep's head and legs on the following page and glue



- Instructions: Tie the wool around the two tubes while leaving the length of string out. Don't wrap the wool too tightly, leave it loose.
 - Keep wrapping till its a few cm's thick, cut the end of the wool and wrap around the centre tightly and tie to the lent that was left out at the end.
 - Cut the end of the wool and then trim the pompom till it's neat and round.
 - Add the sheep's head and legs and glue to the pom
 - Tip: Add a length of wool around the centre and tie together to make a long loop, then the pom pom can be hung up.



Masks

You will need:

- printouts- one per child from the following pages (options for coloured print or a colouring in version) printed on card
- hole punch
- string/ribbon/elastic cut to approx 20-25 cm

- Instructions: Cut out the mask and eye holes and punch out the holes on the ears.
 - Feed the sting through and tie closed.
