Who Celebrates with us

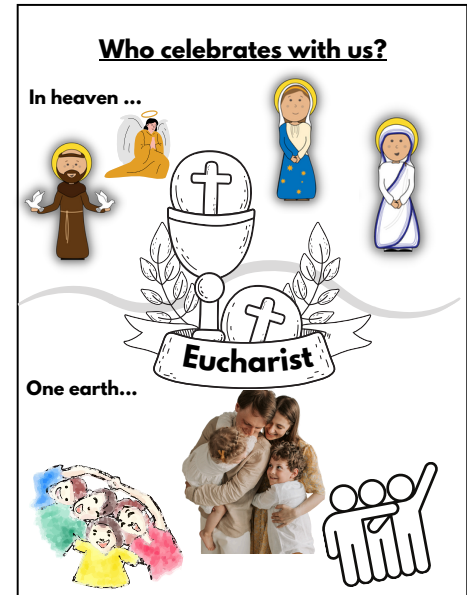


Objective

- To help children understand they don't just celebrate with the people they are at Mass with. All heaven celebrates with us.

Resources

- Pictures of saints, angels as well as pictures of everyday people.
- Colouring pencils/pens
- Scissors
- Glue
- Printouts of the following page (who celebrates with us) one per child



Instructions

- On the top half of the page the children add picture/photos of people in heaven who celebrate Mass with us and on the bottom half the people who celebrate with us in person here on earth; friends family, our community.

Version 2

- This activity can be done as a group, with a large piece of butchers paper or a whiteboard. Gather the children round and get them to draw pictures of their own families who come to Mass with them and get them to add the saints they know or family members in heaven who are with us when we celebrate Mass.

Debrief

- *When our community and our families come together at Mass and listen to the word of God in the and then receive the body of God we don't do it by ourselves. There are people all across the world who celebrate in the same way with us.*

And beyond earth, in heaven, the angels and saints join us in this celebration. So next time you are in Mass just think about all the people who are with you. Not just the people in the Church, bbut the people all across the world and in heave who are with you too.
