

# Year C - 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

## Luke 12: 49-53

*Hearts ablaze*



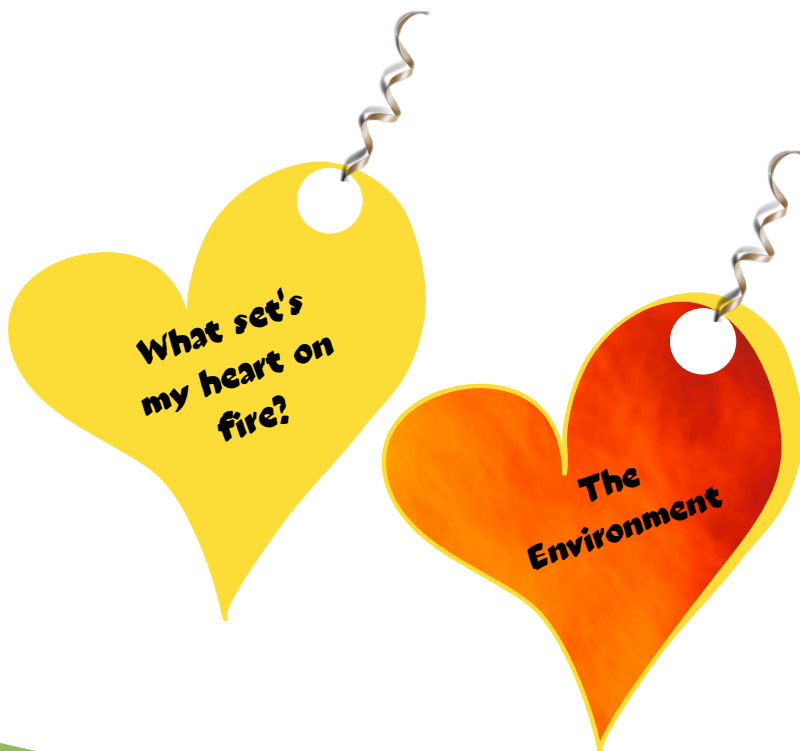
This activity encourages children to consider the things that they are passionate about.

### You will need:

- Plain paper - A6-A5 size
- Coloured paper/ card (red/yellow/orange) (you may want to have these pre-cut in to large hearts)
- Coloured pens/pencils/crayons/pastels
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Hole punch
- Ribbons - pre-cut into for 10-15cm
- Marker pens (optional)

### Instructions:

1. On the plain paper, get the children to colour it in with the colours of fire (it doesn't need to be in the shape of a fire)
2. Then cut that page out into the shape of a heart. Glue that onto the coloured card and cut again into the shape of a larger heart (so there is a coloured border).
3. Use the hole punch to make a small hole in the top corner and feed the ribbon through and tie off to create a loop.
4. Ask the children to write on their hearts something that they are passionate about. They may want to include a question like 'What set's my heart a fire?' or 'What am I passionate about?'



### Tip:

Use crayons or pastels and draw thick lines of red, orange and yellow then blend the colours with your fingers (it would be helpful to have wet wipes or a handwashing station for afterwards.)
