## Year C - 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 14:1, 7-14

Three on a couch



## You will need:

- A couch that can seat three people
- Chairs for everyone else (alternatively, have chairs for the couch and others sit on the floor)
- Have one extra chair available
- Slips of paper, write the names of the players on the paper (one on each slip)

## How to play:

- 1. Separate the players into two teams and have something to easily identify the team (eg girls v boys or Team A all wear a hat).
- 2. The aim of the game is to fill the couch with players from your team.
- 3. The teams then have to alternate seats so no one is sat next to a team mate. Begin with the empty space on the couch and one person from each team on the other spaces on the couch.
- 4. Hand out the slips of paper to each player it doesn't matter if they have or don't have their own name.
- 5. Starting with the person clockwise of the empty space they call out the name of another player. Whoever has that name on the slip they are holding moves into the empty space. They then swap the pieces of paper with each other.
- 6. Keep going around the circle, players have to keep track of who has whose name and aim to get the other team off the couch and their team on.
