

Year C - 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 14:1, 7-14

Take your placemats



You will need:

- Coloured paper/card
- Coloured strips of paper
Approx 3cm wide
- Pencil & ruler
- Scissors
- Glue sticks/Double sided tape
- Scripture written/printed on coloured paper
- Laminator & Laminator pouches



Instructions:

1.



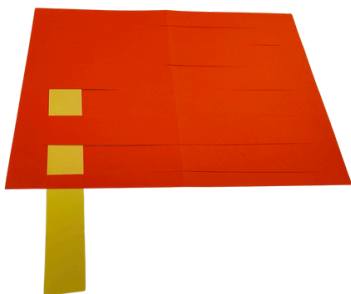
Fold the card in half and draw lines from the fold line to about 2 cm from the edge of the paper and space 3-4 cm apart.

2.



Cut along these lines making sure to stop before the edge of the page.

3.



Take a coloured strips and feed it through the weaves in the paper, up and down.



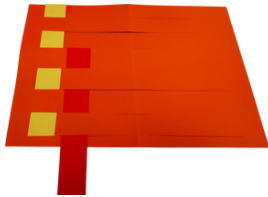
Instructions cont...:

4.



Glue down the strip to the top and bottom to secure it.

5.



Take a second coloured strip of different colour and feed it through alternating to the first to create a checkerboard effect.

6.



Keep going switching between the colours until you fill the card. Glue down your scripture into the centre (this can be a scripture from today's gospel or another)

Tip: Laminate these placemats so they can be used at the dinner table and spills can be easily wiped off.
