For Christians, Pentecost is the celebration where we remember the day the Holy Spirit was sent to the disciples. From that moment onwards the disciples traveled across the world sharing the Gospel and so the Church was born.

This Party Pack aims to help you and the children you connect with to celebrate this momentous day and to help them understand that the Holy Spirit is not just for the disciples, but for all of us who are baptised.

The Birth of the Church

"Do not leave Jerusalem, stay here until you receive the promise from the Father ... you will be baptised with the Holy Spirit." Acts 1:4-5

These were some of the last words Jesus spoke to his disciples, just before he ascended to heaven. He leaves them with this promise, "you will be baptised with the Holy Spirit".

And that is exactly what happens at Pentecost. The disciples were gathered together when suddenly a powerful wind, like nothing they had seen before, came rushing through the room. Then, even stranger than that, fire suddenly appeared in the room and separated so that a tongue of fire came to rest on each persons head.

"And all of them were filled with the Holy Spirit."

Acts 2:4

That is when the Church was born. A small group of people hiding away, become the Church! They carried the message of Jesus to every continent, sharing God's life and Spirit with everyone who heard it. That same Spirit falls on each of us thousands of years later.

- · White icing
- · strawberries cut into half

Instructions:

- 1. Give each child a plate, a cupcake and a knife or spoon.
- 2. Have the spread icing on the top of each cupcake.
- Place a piece of strawberry in the centre of each cupcake to look like a 'flame'.
- 4. Sprinkle the top of each cake with the assorted sprinkles.

Flame Crown



You will need:

- Red, orange and/or yellow card
- Scissors
- Glue/double sided tape
- Staples

Instructions:

- 1. Using the stencil below, draw flames of different sizes onto the coloured card and carefully cut out.
- 2. Starting with the smallest, glue each layer onto the next
- 3. With colour of your choice measure and cut out a strip of card which will fit around your head.
- 4. Glue the flames to the centre of the strip and staple the ends together to form a band.
