Agree - Middle - Disagree



This activity encourages the kids to think about the things that do and do not bring us closer to God.

- How to play: 1. Listen Carefully: I will read out a statement. Each statement will be about something we do in our daily lives.
 - 2. Think About It: Think about whether you agree with the statement, disagree with it, or if you're not sure and feel somewhere in the middle.
 - 3. Choose Your Spot: If you agree with the statement, stand on the side of the room labelled "Agree."
 - 4. If you disagree with the statement, stand on the side of the room labelled "Disagree."
 - 5. If you're not sure or feel somewhere in the middle, stand in the middle of the room.
 - 6. Share Your Thoughts: Once everyone has chosen their spot, we will talk about why we chose to stand where we did. Remember, there are no wrong answers, and it's okay to have different opinions.

Statements

- Praying every day helps us feel closer to God.
- Ignoring someone who needs help does not bring us closer to God.
- Being mean to others makes God sad.
- Not listening to our parents or teachers does not make God happy.
- Taking things that don't belong to us makes God unhappy.
- Reading stories from the Bible teaches us about God's love.
- Helping those in need is a way to show God's love.
- Singing songs of praise makes us feel connected to God.
- Lying to our friends does not bring us closer to God.
- Being kind to others makes God happy.
