Year C - 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 16:19-31

An activity to help children unpack the gospel reading.



Messages from God:

- One of the ways we know how to live the life God wants for us is through the commandments he gave to Moses on Mount Sinai.
 And throughout the old testament God would speak to his prophets telling them messages to share with his people.
 Messages about loving and respecting one another and God.
- Get the children to imagine they are the messengers that God has chosen. What message would he have for his people today. As a group write them down on 'stone tablets'.

Ideas for stone tablets:

- Cut out carboard into the shape of stone tablets and cover in grey/silver wrapping paper or tissue paper. And wrinkles and shadows to make it look older.
- You van use quick drying clay and etch the words into the damp clay.
- Or you can use liquid chalk and draw them onto a large window that is available.
- Make a modern version of the tablet like a device and add to it. You can
 do this by projecting it onto a whiteboard, creating it in power point or
 printing them out.
