My Prayer Book



Background

Sometimes when we pray, God will seem to answer right away.
Other times, we will have to wait a long time for God to answer. God is answering all along. Sometimes, God says yes. Sometimes, God says no. And sometimes, God says wait.

You will need

- Card 2 per child
- paper
- pencils
- scissors
- hole punch
- string or ribbon

Instructions

- 1. Draw around the child's hand in a 'prayer hand' shape on a sheet of card.
- 2. Layer the first sheet of card, following by about 10 sheets of paper, with the sheet of card with the hand outline on top.
- 3. Holding the stack of card and paper securely, cut around the hand outline.
- 4. Keeping the card and paper secure, punch two holes on the pinkie side of the hand.
- 5. Thread the string or ribbon through the holes and tie together to make a book.
- 6. Encourage the children to draw or write their prayers in their Prayer Book.
