

Year C - Feast of Christ the King

Luke 23:35-43

Finger Paint Prayer



Overview

This simple prayer experience invites each of the children to ask Jesus to be the king of their hearts.

You will need

- A large cardboard cross
- A small pallet of water colour paints (dampen each of the colours)
- Wet wipes
- A small bin

Prayer

- Invite the children to make the Sign of the Cross.
- Remind them about how Jesus is the King of Kings.
- Remind them about what Jesus' kingdom is like (you may even get responses from them).
- Explain that we can ask Jesus to be the King of our hearts so that we can be people who make this world a place of love, peace and justice.
- Invite the children (if they want to), one at a time, to touch the coloured paint of their choice and place their fingerprint on the cross, to show that they are inviting Jesus to be the Kings of their hearts.
- Once everyone has had a turn, finish your time of prayer with the Our Father.
