CELEBRATING ALL SAINTS SAINTS GAME CARDS

Get to know some of the saints with these Saints game cards. Print the pages on card (laminate if you wish). Here are two ways to play.

MEMORY

For this game you will need to print two copies of the cards (for a big group game print on A3).

Objective: Find matching pairs of cards by remembering their positions (for 2 or more players).

Set up: Shuffle the cards and lay all cards face down in a grid pattern.

How to Play: Players take turns flipping two cards face up. If the cards match, the player keeps the pair and takes another turn. If they don't match, flip them back face down and the next player goes. Try to remember where cards are for future turns!

How to win: The game ends when all pairs are found. The player with the most pairs wins.



WHO'S MY SAINT?

For this game you will need to print a set of two small copies of the cards (suggest using A5) and a set of two larger copies (suggest using A4. for a big group game print on A4 and A3 respectively.

Objective: Figure out the mystery character your opponent has chosen by asking yes/no questions. (for 2 or more players).

Set up: Prepare each large set of saints cards (use business card stands to keep them upright) on opposite sides of a playing area. Then have each player secretly choose one character from their set of small cards.

How to play: Players take turns asking yes/no questions to narrow down the possibilities. e.e. "Does your character wear glasses?" or "Is your character from the Old Testament?" Based on the answer, eliminate characters that don't match. Keep asking until someone guesses the correct character.

How to win: The first player to correctly guess the opponent's character wins!
