Hi, I'm Pier Giorgio Frassati and I'm a living Saint! I was born in Turin, in Italy 1901 to two very influential parents. When I was a child I joined a regular prayer group and obtained permission to receive communion daily which was pretty special for my time. My faith grew and grew and I always loved to share about my faith with my friends.

When I was 17 years old I joined the Saint Vincent de Paul Society and loved to dedicate my free time to serving the sick and the needy. I had the privilege of serving all kinds of people; the sick, the dying, orphans and even caring for the demobilized servicemen returning from World War I. After I finished school, I decided I wanted to become a mining engineer so I could serve Christ better among them, and so I began studying at the local University in Turin. I would often give the money for my bus fare to the poor and run home for dinner.
