## CELEBRATING ALL SAINTS SAINT POPE JOHN PAUL II

St Pope John Paul II (or JPII for short) was born as Karol Wojtyła in Poland in 1920. As a boy, he loved playing football, acting in plays, and spending time outdoors. But his life changed when his mother, brother, and father all died while he was still young. Even though he was sad, he trusted God and grew stronger in his faith.



During World War II, Karol secretly studied to become a priest because it was dangerous to do so openly. He became a priest, then a bishop, and later a cardinal. In 1978, he was chosen to be the Pope, the leader of the Catholic Church, and took the name John Paul II. He travelled all over the world to share God's love, especially with young people. He taught that every person is special and loved by God. Even when he was very sick and old, he kept smiling and praying. He died in 2005 and was later made a saint. Today, we remember him as a joyful and brave friend of Jesus who helped many people grow closer to God.
