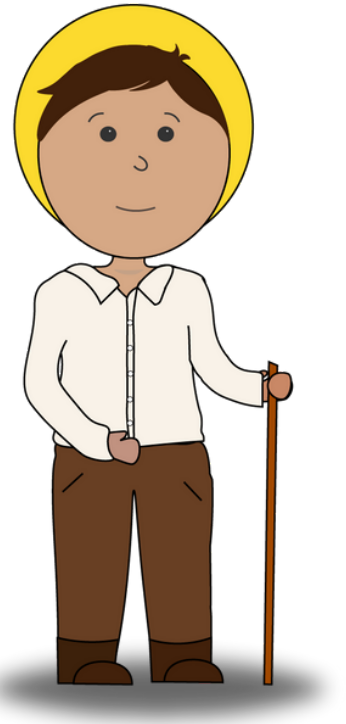


CELEBRATING ALL SAINTS

PUPPET STORIES

The following pages show some backdrop scenes where Pier would have walked, there are also some puppet characters to play along with, your job is to have some fun acting out the daily life of Pier as he walks around his town, helping people and going on adventures up the mountains!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Stapler
- Scissors
- Backdrop scenes (below)
- Puppet characters (below)



INSTRUCTIONS:

- Backdrop Setup - Staple the short edges of the four background scenes together to form a square.
- Character Preparation - Cut out Pier and create three additional characters (e.g. a homeless person, the Parish Priest, a university friend). Colour them as you imagine they would look.
- Character Stands - Fold the lines attached to each character into circles and staple them so the characters can stand upright.
- Act Out the Story - Use the characters and backdrop to perform a story where Pier: Serves the homeless person, attends Mass, hikes up the mountain
- Invite friends to help play the different roles.
