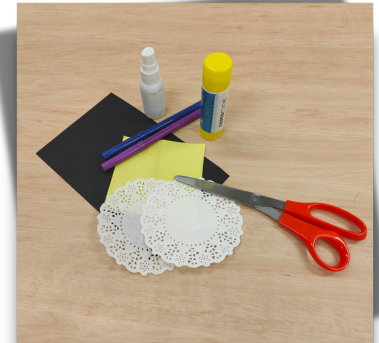
Dreaming Angels



Background The decorations we put up are one of the ways we can prepare for Christmas. This bauble includes images of the Christmas story, so when we look at it on our tree we are reminded of the joy that is coming.

You will need:

- Coloured paper/card
- Small paper doyleys (paper coffee filters work well too)
- Paper towels
- 2-3 coloured pens
- Spray bottle with water
- Glue
- Scissors (if needed)



Instructions:

1. Cut out a simple silhouette of an angel without wings. To save time these can be prepared ahead of time.

2. Colour in the paper doyleys or filters in two or three colours (careful when using contrasting colours that when they blend won't go muddy coloured)

Tip: put down some paper towels, it can get messy save time these can be prepared ahead of time.

3. Spray the paper liberally and pat dry with the paper towel.

4. Once mostly dry, fold the paper into wing shapes and glue to the back of the silhouette.

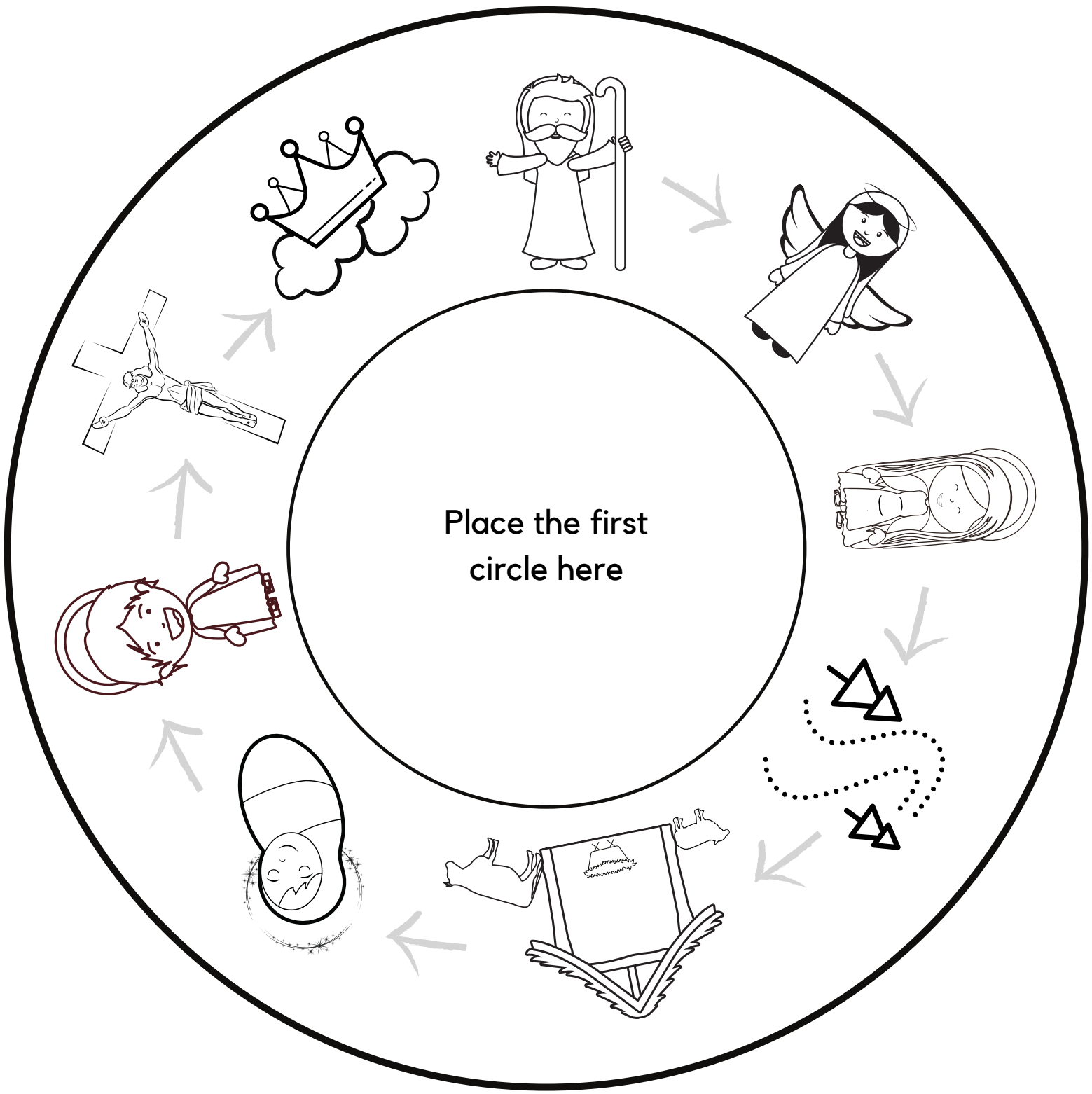

5. Cut out the a circle and glue on the back of a head for a halo

Tip: tape a piece of string and tie it into a loop to make a Christmas ornament.
