- Cut around the figures and their base. (Optional: You may want to laminate the figures and cut them to shape again, to create a sturdier figurine.) Some figures like the infant Jesus and the star don't have a base, you can use blue tak to stick them to another figure like Mary or the manger or hang the star
- 3. Bend the strips at the foot of the figure behind it to form a base and glue or tape together.
