

Year A - 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

John 1:29-34

What Stories do you know about Jesus?



Background This activity is designed to help the children think about what they know about Jesus so that they can share what they know about him, just like John the Baptist did.

Set up

- Get the children to pair up with each other and ask them to take it in turns to name a few things they know about Jesus. It could be a story they know about him, it could be about what he looks like from pictures they've seen of him, or it could be something they heard Jesus speak to them in prayer.
- If some children can't think of something get them to reflect on the craft they did earlier and think about the stories from there.
- Give them one minute each to share something.
- Then bring back their attention and ask a few of them to recall what their partner spoke about.

Debrief

- What you've all just done is share the Good News of Jesus with each other!
- You can talk about Jesus with everyone! In fact Jesus wants us to talk about him with everyone, even with people who don't know Him.
- What you've just done is practicing sharing Jesus with each other, the challenge is to be like John the Baptist and try and share what we know about Jesus with everyone we meet.
