### You will need



- Printouts of the following 2 pages double sided.






**Step 1:** Fold your A4 piece of paper into quarters and crease well from both sides of the paper.




**Step 3:** cut along the centre fold shown by the bold line.




**Step 5:** Continue pushing it together until it forms four pages




**Step 2:** Fold sides into the middle and crease well from both sides of the paper.




**Step 4:** Fold in half then push ends towards each other to open the middle.




**Step 6:** Colour and write in your pages and fold together to form your story book.






