Introduction:

 John the Baptist was a prophet, he had a special job to tell people that the Messiah, Jesus was coming. But when Jesus was there, his job wasn't over, he still told people all about Jesus.

Message:

- John told the people about what he had seen Jesus do and his work helped to spread the Good News, that Jesus is here for us.
- The job of sharing the Good News isn't just the job of prophets like John the Baptist, or our priests or teachers. It's everyone's job!
- You can share the Good News by telling other people what you know about Jesus and by telling everyone how much Jesus loves them.
- Share a story from your own life about at time you felt close to Jesus or learnt something special about Jesus and shared that story with someone else.
