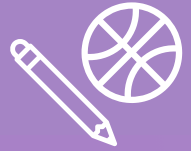


# Year A - Fourth Sunday of Lent

## John 4:5-15, 19-26, 39, 40-42

Different, yet the same



### Background

Jesus didn't care that the woman was from a different place or that people said Jews and Samaritans shouldn't talk. He saw her heart. He spoke to her with kindness and offered her something incredible — Living Water, the gift of eternal life. This story teaches us that even though we're all different in many ways, we are the same in the most important way: we are all loved by God and invited to be part of His family. Let's explore all the unique things about ourselves and share them with each other!

### You will need

- Paper for each child
- Coloured pens / pens

### Instructions

- Invite the children to draw a picture of themselves in the middle of the paper

- Invite the children to share what they have written about themselves so that they can see how similar yet different they are.
