Year A - Third Sunday of Lent John 4:5-15, 19-26, 39, 40-42

The living well



Background

- The woman came for ordinary water, but Jesus offered Living Water.
- Just like the bucket brings water up from the well, Jesus brings us life and joy that never runs out.

- You will need Paper cup (to represent the well)
 - Blue ribbon, yarn, or strips of paper (to represent water)
 - Popsicle stick (to represent the bucket handle)
 - Small paper circle or cup bottom (bucket)
 - Markers or crayons
 - Glue or tape

Instructions

- Give each child a paper cup. Let them colour or decorate the outside to look like stones or bricks.
- Cut out a small circle of paper or use the bottom of another cup. Attach it to a popsicle stick with tape or glue to make a "bucket."
- Cut strips of blue paper or ribbon. Glue them inside the bucket so it looks like it's carrying water.
- Place the bucket inside the "well" (the cup). Kids can pull the bucket out and pretend to "draw water."
- On the cup write the words: "Jesus gives us Living Water" on the outside.
