### Healing Stations



### You will need

- Posters of different images to pray for (see the list for ideas)
- A way of attaching the posters to the wall
- Band aids
- A cross, or a focal point for prayer.

### Ideas for Prayer stations

- The world
- Our relationships
- The sick
- Our Church



### Set up

- Set up the posters around the room and in a central space set up a prayer focus point, include a cross, bible and/or candle. Around the prayer space
- have bandaids spread out.
- Point out the posters to the children and explain what each one means eg There are places in our world that have been affected by earthquakes or floods or devastation, we pray for those places and the people in them that they can be healed. In our relationships, sometimes there are things we or others say or do that can hurt that relationship, in those times we can pray for healing.
- Invite the children to take a bandaid and to go put it on the poster. As they do ask say the prayer, Jesus heal ...(the world, our relationships etc).
- They can come back for more band aids and cover each of the posters.
- Once they are done, bring the children back and say a brief prayer together to end your time of prayer.
