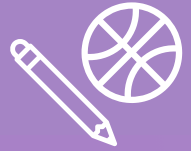


# Year A - Fifth Sunday of Lent

## John 11:3-7, 11, 20-27, 31-45

### Wrapping Lazarus Relay



### You will need

- Several rolls of toilet paper
- Two willing volunteers (perhaps a couple of your parish teens or youth coordinators?)

### Option 2: Reading without seeing

- Break the group of children into two teams and assign one of the volunteers to be the 'Lazarus' for that team.
- Line each team up at one end of your space and place the teams 'Lazarus' at the other end.
- When the leader says 'go', the first person in each line must pick up a roll of toilet paper, run to 'Lazarus' and wrap as much toilet paper around 'Lazarus' as possible. The catch is that each runner only has a set number of seconds before they have to return to their line. (You can determine how long each runner has based on the age of the children - 10secs for older children and more for little ones).
- When a team has run out of toilet paper they finish by calling out 'come out' to 'Lazarus' as a team.
