Drawing Prayer



Overview

In Ignatian prayer, we are encouraged to put ourselves in the gospel stories to help us understand what's happening. In this prayer, we'll ask the children to draw themselves in a story with Jesus and ask them to write what they think Jesus would say to them.

Instructions

Ask the children to draw a picture of one of their favourite stories of Jesus but ask them to put themselves in the picture too. If they are old enough ask them to add speech bubbles and ask what Jesus would say to them and what they would say to Jesus.

Remind the children that this is a way of praying and something they can do anytime they want to feel close to Jesus.

Finish with a final prayer altogether thanking Jesus for our time with him today and ask for help to share the good news with others.
