

# Year A - The Epiphany of the Lord

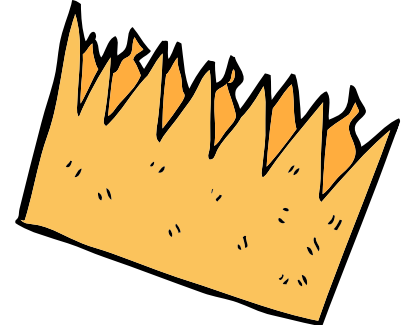
## Matthew 2: 1-12

### The Kings Crown



### Introduction

The Magi were looking for the King of the Jews and they found him not in a royal palace but lying in a manger. What better way for children to celebrate the Epiphany but with their own crown.



### You will need

- See following page for crown template (They would be best printed on thicker paper or card.)
- Crowns pre-cut for the younger children
- Craft glue
- Decorations e.g. sequins, stickers, jewels, glitter
- Stapler
- Coloured pencils or felt pens
- Scissors

### Instructions

1. Give each child a crown and access to pencils, pens, decorations and glue
2. When they are finished decorating their crown, hold it around their head to measure the right size. Staple twice to make a circle.
3. If the children will let you, allow the crowns time to dry before they wear them
