My Footprint



Background

This activity continues to teach children that Jesus is the way that we should follow. Make a footprint pathway on a large piece of butchers paper that leads to a figure of Jesus (See next page).

You will need

- Coloured paper (one sheet per child)
- Pencils or felt-tip markers
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Large sheet of butcher's paper
- A picture of Jesus (pre-glued to the top of the butcher's paper)

Instructions

- Give each child a coloured piece of paper and a pencil or marker.
- Ask each child to remove one shoe and trace around their foot. Alternatively, they can trace around their shoe if preferred.
- Children cut out their traced foot shape. Adults should assist younger children with cutting.
- Each child glues their footprint onto the butcher's paper. Make sure the footprints are arranged to lead toward the picture of Jesus at the top of the page.

Debrief

In John 14:6, Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life." This activity reminds us that Jesus is the path to God. Just like our footprints lead toward His picture, our choices and actions can lead us closer to Him.
