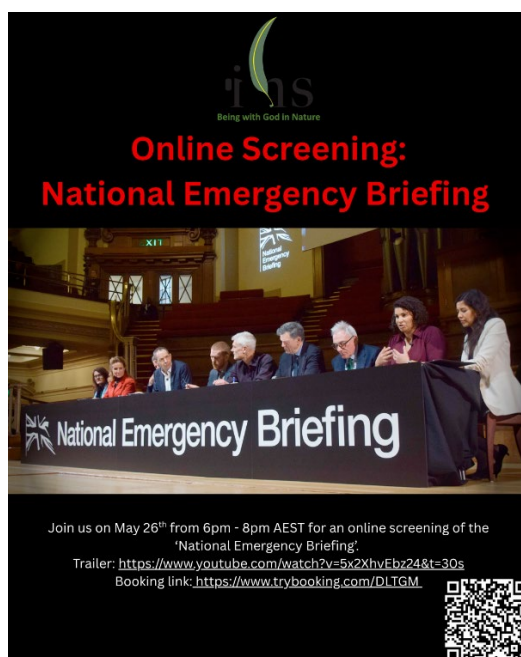


## 3. Online Screening: National Emergency Briefing
