Background

Let's show what its like to sow the seeds of God's kingdom by doing acts of kindness for each other.

You will need

- Posted notes
- Markers

Instructions

Write on the post it notes a range of good deeds that the children can do right away.

Here are some ideas:

- Tell someone they have a nice smile
- Tell someone one thing you like about them
- Give someone a hug
- Find someone you don't know and introduce yourself
- Ask someone to tell you about their hobby.
- Pick up some rubbish
- Write a note for your parents to tell them you love them
- Give a high five.
- Smile at someone.
- Tell someone your favourite bible story.



Put a post-it on each child and ask them to do whats on the post-it. Once they have done it, they have to stick it on someone else and then that person has to do the task. When they have passed on their post its they have to find another from someone else.

Give the children 5-10 minutes with this activity and they will done a variety of tasks. Gather the children together again and explain to them that this is what it's like to be a worker in God's fields. There is always something to be done, some way that we can make other people feel loved and special and in doing so we show them how much God loves them and how special they are to him.
