Harvest Time



Introduction

- To help the children understand that what we do and say helps us be workers or disciples of Christ. Make these 'fruits of the harvest' and make it a goal to complete each task by next week.

You will need

- Coloured paper (pick colours to match fruits and food to be harvest, eg orange pumpkins green apples etc)
- Words from the following page printed onto the coloured paper
- Stapler and Staples
- Scissors

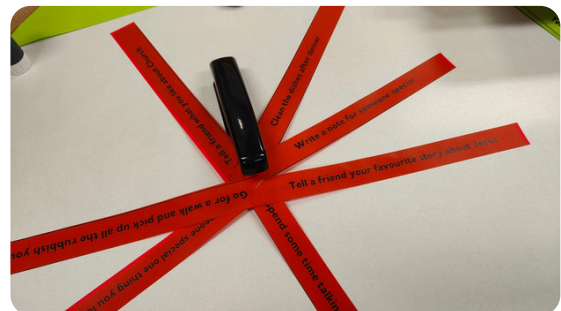


Instructions

1. Print the following page onto coloured paper and cut into strips.



2. Arrange the strips into a star shape with one end overlapping each strip and staple together.



3. Take the other ends of the strips and overlap them each and staple together to create a round shape (the shorter the strips the smaller the fruit).



4. Create a stem by rolling some brown paper and seal it with glue, and cut out a circle and glue/staple to your fruit.
