

Year A - The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

John 6: 51-58

Paper host with Jesus



Background At Mass, during the Eucharist, the priest prays a special prayer called the epiclesis. During this prayer the Holy Spirit changes the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus. This little craft is a reminder that, though the host may still look like bread, it's true essence has become Jesus himself.

You will need

- a printed template for each child
- scissors
- pens and pencils
- split pins

Instructions

- Have the children cut out the templates.
- Invite the children to draw a picture of Jesus on the circle (note - the dot on the circle goes to the bottom of the finished craft).
- Stack the pieces of the template so that the dots align. Ensure that the circle with the drawing of Jesus is placed on the bottom of the stack.
- Insert the split pin through the templates as indicated by the dots.
